Premier Dalton McGuinty has launched an attack on pension plans for thousands of Ontarians, including most OPSEU members. Too few people have pensions, but instead of fixing that problem, McGuinty is creating a new one.

OPSEU is hosting four Tele Town Halls on a Regional basis about this and I hope you will participate in one for Regions 3 and 4. We need to safeguard pensions now under attack **and** secure pensions for more people. There's video and lots of information at a new website.
